Yes / No</p> <p>This includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Over 70s - People with a lung condition that’s not severe (such as asthma, COPD, emphysema or bronchitis) - People who have heart disease (such as heart failure) - People with diabetes - People with chronic kidney disease - People with liver disease - People with conditions affecting the brain or nerves (such as Parkinson’s disease, motor neurone disease, multiple sclerosis or cerebral palsy) - People who have a condition that means they have a high risk of getting infections - People who are taking medicine that affects the immune system (such as low dose steroids) - People who are obese (a BMI of 40 or above) - Pregnant women <p>The Government advice is that people in this category can now follow the advice of the general population, so treatment can take place. However, it is important for me to know if you or anyone in your household falls into this category so I can ensure that extra safety measures are in place when you attend for your session. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.</p>

(If you were required to shield, you would have received an NHS letter or have been contacted by your GP) Yes / No</p> <p>This currently includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Solid organ transplant recipients - People with specific cancers: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o People with cancer who are undergoing active chemotherapy or radical radiotherapy for lung cancer o People with cancers of the blood or bone marrow such as leukaemia, lymphoma or myeloma who are at any stage of treatment o People having immunotherapy or other continuing antibody treatments for cancer o People having other targeted cancer treatments which can affect the immune system, such as protein kinase inhibitors or PARP inhibitors o People who have had bone marrow or stem cell transplants in the last 6 months, or who are still taking immunosuppression drugs - People with severe respiratory conditions including all cystic fibrosis, severe asthma and severe Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD) - People with severe single organ disease (e.g. Liver, Cardio, Renal, Neurological). - People with rare diseases and inborn errors of metabolism that significantly increase the risk of infections (such as Severe Combined Immunodeficiency (SCID), homozygous sickle cell). - People on immunosuppression therapies sufficient to significantly increase risk of infection. - Pregnant women with significant heart disease, congenital or acquired. - Children up to the age of 18 with significant heart disease, congenital or acquired. <p>In Wales, those classed as “extremely clinically vulnerable” and advised to shield were able to cease shielding on 16th August 2020.
